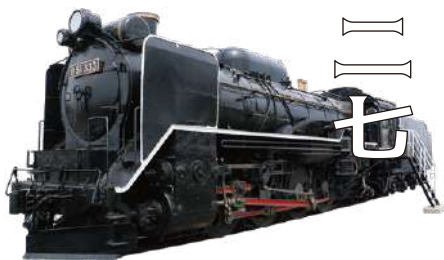
Afunruparo, an Ainu sacred cave, means "entrance to the afterlife" in the Ainu language. The surrounding rock walls create a breathtaking landscape.

Located in southwestern Hokkaido, Shiraori is just a 40-minute drive from New Chitose Airport, the gateway to Hokkaido, and about an hour by express train from JR Sapporo Station, making it highly accessible by land, sea, and air. With its elongated shape, the town is perfect for scenic drives, offering endless views of the Pacific Ocean to the south and Mt. Taruame to the northeast. The stunning landscapes visible from every window are a highlight. Forests make up 70% of the town, and its rivers, rich enough for salmon to swim upstream, provide opportunities to encounter wildlife. Strolling through this nature-filled environment is one of the town's great pleasures. Artistic spots are scattered throughout the town, making for a leisurely and enjoyable visit.
